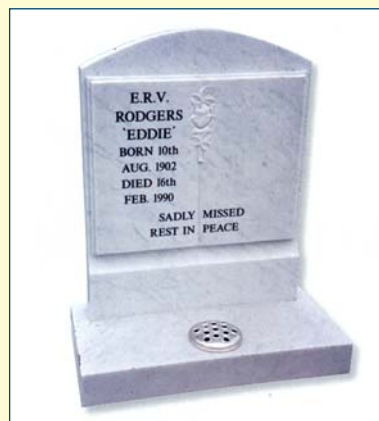
Memorials Sculptured in Italian White Marble

White Marble lends itself to fine carving, particularly for statuary or religious carvings. Unfortunately the Church of England regulations for memorials in churchyards will prohibit the use of White Marble for a memorial, whereas this material will be permitted in most Local Authority run cemeteries.

Most of the following memorial designs can also be carved in Stone.



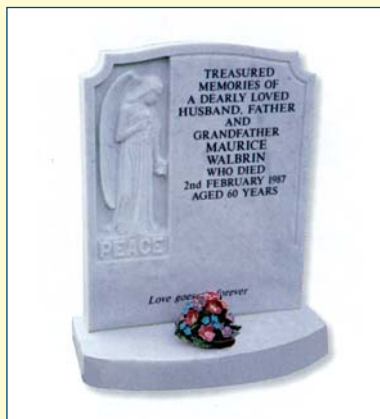

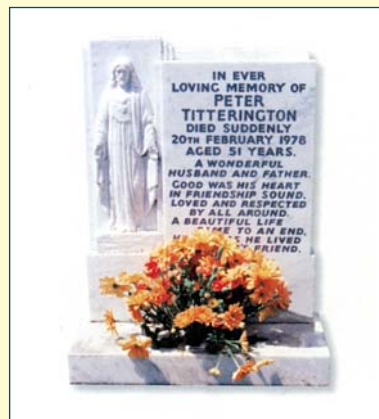

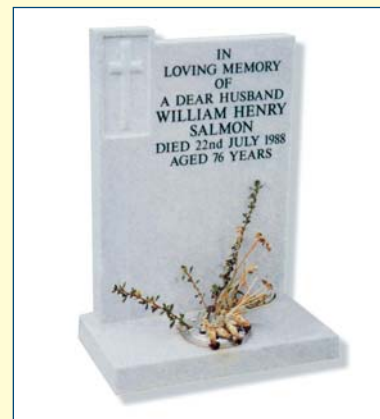

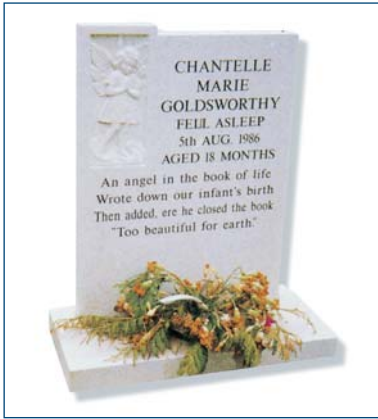

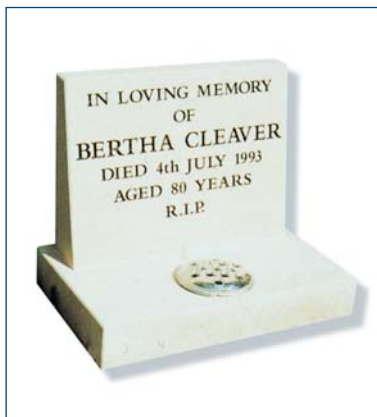

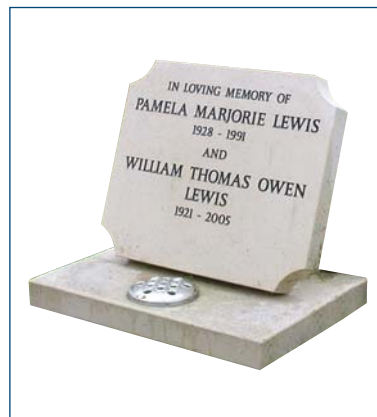
